As you may have heard, the release of the 2010 FCAT results for Grades 4-10 in reading, mathematics, writing and science have been delayed. On Friday, June 4th Superintendents received an email from Florida Department of Education Chancellor Frances Haithcock indicating the results are likely to be delayed until the end of June. Please be assured that once the FCAT test results are released to our district, we will distribute them as soon as possible. We recognize student and teacher schedules may be impacted by the FCAT results. It is our intention to prepare and revise student schedules and teacher assignments based on the FCAT results as quickly as possible.

We appreciate your patience as you await, with your school district, the results of the 2010 FCAT administration. We will continue to communicate as we receive information from the Department of Education and will post updates on the SCPS website (Superintendent e-News).
